



Cute pompom project

You won't be able to resist stroking the fabulous textured surface of this eye-catching bag

This striking bag is made in Rico Pompon which is a fun novelty yarn that's easier than it looks to knit up. We've used a fresh turquoise shade and bamboo handles complete the look nicely. Rico Pompon costs £8.99 per 200g (100m) ball from The Wool Sak, www.wool-sak.co.uk

Bag

Using 4mm needles and yarn A cast on 28 sts

K every row placing first pompom after first and foll odd-numbered sts
NOTE: Work only on yarn, briefly holding pompoms between index and middle finger as you

work. There should be 14 pompoms on each row When work meas 80cm cut a generous length of yarn and pull through sts

To make up

Sew in all ends. Block as necessary, dampen and leave to dry. Fold bag in half along short side and sew up side seams for 35cm. Sew bag handle onto top edge seam
