YOU'LL ALSO NEED:

Needles: 3mm
Beads: black, 4mm, two per dog
Sewing cotton and thread
Safety toy stuffing
Tapestry needle

Start knitting here...

Beth Beagle

HEAD

Using 3mm needles and yarn A, cast on ten sts
 Row 1 (WS): p to end
 Row 2: (kfb) in each st to end. 20 sts
 Row 3: p to end
 Row 4: (k1, kfb) to end. 30 sts
Join in yarn B

NOTE: letter foll instruction indicates yarn shade. See panel overleaf for guidance on intarsia colour work

Row 5: p13 A, p4 B, join another end of yarn A, p13 A
 Rows 6-13: keeping colours correct, and beg with a k row, work in st st
 Row 14 (eyeline): (k9, [k2tog] twice) A, ([k2tog] twice) B, ([k2tog] twice, k9) A. 24 sts
 Row 15: keeping colours correct, p to end
 Row 16: (k8, k2tog, k1) A, k2tog B, (k1,

k2tog, k8) A. 21 sts
Cut yarn A and cont in yarn B only
 Rows 17-21: beg with a p row, work in st st
 Row 22: (k1, k2tog) to end. 14 sts
 Cut yarn leaving a tail, thread through rem sts, pull tight and fasten off

BODY

Using 3mm needles and yarn B, cast on ten sts
 Row 1 (WS): p to end
 Row 2: (kfb) in each st to end. 20 sts
 Row 3: p to end
 Row 4: k2, (kfb, k2) to end. 26 sts
 Rows 5-13: beg with a p row, cont in st st
 Row 14: k2, (k2tog, k2) to end. 20 sts
 Rows 15-19: beg with a p row, work in st st
 Row 20: k2tog, (k1, k2tog) to end. 13 sts
 Cut yarn, leaving a tail, thread through rem sts, pull tight and fasten off

FRONT LEGS (make two)

Using 3mm needles and yarn B, cast on five sts
 Row 1 (WS): p to end
 Row 2: (kfb) in each st to end. Ten sts
 Rows 3-11: beg with a p row, work in st st
 Row 12: (k2tog) to end. Five sts
 Cut yarn leaving a tail, thread through rem sts, pull tight and fasten off

BACK LEGS (make two)

Using 3mm needles and yarn B, cast on eight sts
 Row 1 (WS): p to end
 Row 2: (kfb) in each st to end. 16 sts
 Rows 3-5: beg with a p row, work in st st
 Row 6 (shape ankle): k6, (k2tog) twice, k6. 14 sts
 Row 7: p6, p2tog, p6. 13 sts
 Rows 8-12: beg with a k row, cont in st st
 Row 13: p1, (p2tog) to end. Seven sts
 Cut yarn leaving a tail, thread through rem sts, pull tight and fasten off



EARS (make two)

Using 3mm needles and yarn A, cast on 12 sts
 Rows 1-3: beg with a p (WS) row, work in st st
 Row 4: (k2, k2tog) to end. Nine sts
 Row 5: p to end
 Row 6: (k1, k2tog) to end. Six sts
 Row 7: p to end
 Cut yarn leaving a tail, thread through rem sts, pull tight and fasten off

TAIL

Using 3mm needles and yarn C, cast on eight sts
 Beg with a p (WS) row, work five rows in st st
 Cut yarn leaving a tail, thread through rem sts, pull tight and fasten off

SCARF

Using 3mm needles and yarn E, cast on four sts
 K 70 rows
 Cast off

TO MAKE UP

Using fastened-off yarn tail, seam Head half way. Gather cast-on edge, stuff Head and close seam. Using yarn A, work a gathering thread over eyeline on face and pull to shape dent. Seam Ears and with seam in front centre, attach to Head. Attach eye beads and using Dark brown 4ply yarn, embroider nose with short backstitches. Seam and stuff Body as for Head. Seam each leg. Insert a threaded needle through sole of Back leg, take it out from ankle and return. Pull to flatten sole and shape ankle. Attach all legs to Body. Attach Head to Body. Tie Scarf around neck



Sam Schnauzer

HEAD

Using 3mm needles and yarn C throughout, work as for Beth Beagle until Row 17 is complete. 21 sts
Cut yarn C and join in yarn B
 Rows 18-23: beg with a k row, work in st st
 Row 24: (k1, k2tog) to end. 14 sts
 Cut yarn leaving a tail, thread through rem sts, pull tight and fasten off

FRONT AND BACK LEGS

Using yarn C, work as for Beth Beagle



BONUS TOY patterns



EARS (make two)

Using 3mm needles and yarn C, cast on ten sts
 Row 1 (WS): p to end
 Row 2: (k3, k2tog) to end. Eight sts
 Row 3: p to end
 Row 4: (k2tog) to end. Four sts
 Row 5: (p2tog) to end. Two sts
 Row 6: k2tog. One st
 Fasten off

TAIL

Using 3mm needles and yarn C, cast on ten sts
 Beg with a p (WS) row, work five rows in st st
 Cut yarn leaving a tail, thread through rem sts, pull tight and fasten off

SCARF

Using 3mm needles and yarn E, cast on three sts
 K 60 rows
 Cast off

TO MAKE UP

Make up Body, Ears, Legs and Head as for Beth Beagle. For eyebrows, backstitch three times over each eye. For hair, backstitch from side of muzzle, leaving long loops every other stitch. Cut loops

great ADVICE



"Leave a 15cm yarn tail at the beginning and end for sewing up and join seams using mattress stitch. Use intarsia colourwork for the beagle's head"

Trevor Terrier

HEAD

- Work as for Sam Schnauzer, using yarn A throughout

FRONT AND BACK LEGS

- Using yarn D, work as for Back legs of Beth Beagle

BODY

- Using yarn D, work as for Beth Beagle

EARS AND TAIL

- Using yarn A, work as for Sam Schnauzer

SCARF

- Using yarn E, work as for Sam Schnauzer

TO MAKE UP

Make up Body, Ears, Legs and Head as for Beth Beagle, attaching Front legs to fastened-off end of Body. Make hair as for Sam Schnauzer. Attach yarn at base of Ears and separate strands

Charlie Chihuahua

HEAD

Using 3mm needles and yarn B, cast on ten sts

- Row 1 (WS): p to end
- Row 2: (kfb) in each st to end. 20 sts
- Rows 3-9: beg with a p row, work in st st
- Row 10: k5, (k2tog) five times, k5. 15 sts



- rows in st st
- Cast off

LEGS (make four)

Using 3mm needles and yarn B, cast on eight sts

- Beg with a p (WS) row, work five rows in st st
- Cut yarn leaving a tail, thread through rem sts, pull tight and fasten off

EARS (make two)

Using 3mm needles and yarn B, cast on ten sts

- Rows 1-2: beg with a p (WS) row, work in st st
- Row 3: (p3, p2tog) to end. Eight sts
- Row 4: k to end
- Row 5: (p2tog) to end. Four sts
- Row 6: (k2tog) to end. Two sts
- Row 7: p2tog. One st
- Fasten off

TAIL

Using 3mm needles and yarn B, cast on three sts

- Beg with a p (WS) row, work three rows in st st
- Cut yarn leaving a tail, thread through rem sts, pull tight and fasten off

TO MAKE UP

Make up Body, Ears, Tail and Head, as for Beth Beagle. Sew Leg seams and attach, with front legs at fastened-off end of Body. Attach Jumper collar with WS facing out

- Rows 11-13: beg with a p row, work in st st
- Row 14: (k1, k2tog) to end. Ten sts
- Cut yarn leaving a tail, thread through rem sts, pull tight and fasten off

BODY

Using 3mm needles and yarn B, cast on ten sts

- Row 1 (WS): p to end
- Row 2: (k1, kfb) to end. 15 sts
- Cut yarn B and join in yarn E
- Rows 3-6: p to end
- Rows 7-13: beg with a p row, work in st st
- Row 14: (k1, k2tog) to end. Ten sts
- Rows 15-17: beg with a p row, work in st st
- Cut yarn leaving a tail, thread through rem sts, pull tight and fasten off

JUMPER COLLAR

Using 3mm needles and yarn E, cast on 16 sts

- Beg with a p (WS) row, work four

Sausage Dog

HEAD

Using 3mm needles and yarn D, cast on ten sts

- Row 1 (WS): p to end
- Row 2: (kfb) in each st to end. 20 sts
- Row 3: p to end
- Row 4: (k1, kfb) to end. 30 sts
- Rows 5-9: beg with a p row, work in st st
- Row 10: k5, (k2tog) ten times, k5. 20 sts
- Rows 11-15: beg with a p row, work in st st
- Row 16: k5, (k2tog) five times, k5. 15 sts
- Rows 17-19: beg with a p row, work in st st
- Row 20: (k1, k2tog) to end. Ten sts
- Cut yarn leaving a tail, thread through rem sts, pull tight and fasten off

BODY

Using 3mm needles and yarn D, cast on ten sts

- Row 1 (WS): p to end
- Row 2: (kfb) in each st to end. 20 sts
- Rows 3-13: beg with a p row, work in st st
- Row 14: k5, (k2tog) five times, k5. 15 sts
- Rows 15-20: beg with a p row, work in st st



- Row 21: (p1, p2tog) to end. Ten sts
- Cut yarn leaving a tail, thread through rem sts, pull tight and fasten off

EARS (make two)

Using 3mm needles and yarn D, cast on six sts

- Rows 1-4: beg with a p row, work in st st
- Row 5: p1, (p2tog) twice, p1. Four sts
- Rows 6-7: beg with a k row, work in st st
- Row 8: (k2tog) twice. Two sts
- Pass first st over second st and fasten off

LEGS (make two)

Using 3mm needles and yarn D, cast on seven sts

- Row 1 (WS): p to end
- Row 2: (kfb) in each st to end. 14 sts
- Rows 3-5: beg with a p row, work in st st
- Row 6 (shape ankle): k5, (k2tog) twice, k5. 12 sts
- Row 7: p5, p2tog, p5. 11 sts
- Cast off

TAIL

Using 3mm needles and yarn D, cast on eight sts

- Beg with a p (WS) row, work five rows in st st
- Cut yarn leaving a tail, thread through rem sts, pull tight and fasten off

TO MAKE UP

Using fastened-off yarn tail, seam Head half way. Gather cast-on edge, stuff head and close seam. Using yarn D, work a gathering thread over eyeline on face and pull to shape dent. Without seaming, attach Ears to Head so they hang down. Attach eye beads and, using Black 4ply yarn, embroider nose with short backstitches. Seam and stuff Body as for Head. Seam each leg. Insert a threaded needle through sole, take it out from ankle and return. Pull to flatten sole and shape ankle. Attach all legs to Body, with front legs at fastened-off end

Retriever

HEAD

Using 3mm needles and yarn B, cast on ten sts

- Row 1 (WS): p to end
- Row 2: (kfb) in each st to end. 20 sts
- Row 3: p to end
- Row 4: (k1, kfb) to end. 30 sts
- Rows 5-13: beg with a p row, work in st st
- Row 14 (eyeline): k9, (k2tog) six times, k9. 24 sts
- Row 15: p to end
- Row 16: k8, (k2tog, k1) three times, k7. 21 sts

- Rows 17-23: beg with a p row, work in st st
- Row 24: (k1, k2tog) to end. 14 sts
- Cut yarn leaving a tail, thread through rem sts, pull tight and fasten off

EARS (make two)

Using 3mm needles and yarn B, cast on ten sts

- Row 1 (WS): p to end
- Row 2: (k3, k2tog) to end. Eight sts
- Row 3: p to end
- Row 4: (k2tog) to end. Four sts
- Row 5: (p2tog) to end. Two sts
- Row 6: k2tog. One st
- Fasten off

FRONT LEGS (make two)

Using 3mm needles and yarn B, cast on five sts

- Row 1 (WS): p to end
- Row 2: (kfb) in each st to end. Ten sts
- Rows 3-10: beg with a p row, work eight rows in st st
- Cut yarn leaving a tail, thread through rem sts, pull tight and fasten off

BACK LEGS (make two)

- Work as Front legs until Row 9 is complete
- Cut yarn leaving a tail, thread through rem sts, pull tight and fasten off

TAIL

Using 3mm needles and yarn B, cast on eight sts

- Beg with a p (WS) row, work five rows in st st
- Cut yarn leaving a tail, thread through rem sts, pull tight and fasten off

TO MAKE UP

Using fastened-off yarn tail, seam Head half way. Gather cast-on edge, stuff head and close seam. Using yarn B, work a gathering thread over eyeline on face and pull to shape dent. Seam Ears and with seam in front centre, attach to Head. Attach eye beads and using Brown 4ply yarn, embroider nose with short backstitches. Seam and stuff Body as for Head. Seam each leg. Attach all legs to Body, with front legs at fastened-off end **LK**



Intarsia advice

This colourwork method involves using a separate bobbin of yarn for each new colour introduced on the row but for such small projects, you can use each end of your ball. When you come to switching between colours, give the strands a twist to prevent a hole forming.
