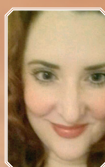

CHAIR PAWS

Protect wooden floors with a set of kitsch knitted socks

We're rather fond of our feline friends here at Crafty HQ, which is why we're completely enamoured with these adorable cat paw chair socks by **NICOLA VALIJI**. The pattern is easy to follow and the paw shape is created by embroidering on claws at the end. Make yours to match your favourite moggy!

chair paws

Make four

Using 3.5mm needles and Radiant Orange cast on 14 sts

Rows 1-2: (k1, p1) to end

Work in foll two-row stripe sequence:

Bright Yellow, Radiant Orange

Rows 3-18: starting with a k row work in st st Change to Striking White

Rows 19-20: starting with a k row work in st st
Row 21: k4, (kfb) in each st to last four sts, k to end. 20 sts

Row 22: p

Row 23: k3, (kfb) in each st to last

three sts, k to end. 34 sts

Rows 24-26: starting with a p row work in st st
Row 27: k5, (yfwd, k2tog, k3) to last four sts, k to end

Row 28: p Change to Brilliant Pink
Row 29: k2tog to end. 17 sts

Row 30: p1, (p2tog) to end.

Nine sts Cut yarn leaving a long tail, thread tail onto tapestry needle and thread through rem sts, fasten off

TO MAKE UP

Sew side seam. Lightly stuff paw. Using spare black yarn embroider five black claws as shown

Great Advice

Place a small amount of stuffing in the base of each paw to help protect your floor. Use the blunt end of a crochet hook to help get the stuffing into the bottom of your sock
